

Dispensary of Hope at Inspira Health FAQs

What is Dispensary of Hope?

Dispensary of Hope provides medication free of cost, with a valid prescription, to the uninsured.

Who qualifies for the program?

I am a U.S. Resident (documented and undocumented)		
I DO NOT have prescription insurance		
❖ I am NOT covered by Medicare D/ Medicaid		
❖ I am NOT covered by TRICARE		
❖ I am NOT covered by the VA		
❖ I do NOT have Affordable Care Act Coverage		
My medical insurance does NOT have a prescription benefit plan		
My income is <300% Federal Poverty Limit (\$40,700 for 1 person, \$54,930 for 2 people, \$69,090 for 3 people, \$83,250 for 4 people)		

You are eligible to receive prescription medications through Dispensary of Hope if you answered YES to all prompts

Do I have to pay any out-of-pocket expense?

No if your medication is on the formulary and you qualify for the program there is no out-of-pocket cost.

How can I enroll into the program?

Fill out the Dispensary of Hope Checklist and Information Form. If you meet eligibility, you will be enrolled. Your provider would need to send your prescriptions over to the Inspira Mullica Hill or Inspira Vineland Retail pharmacy.

How do I know if my current medications are on the formulary?

You can go to Inspiranet. Click on clinical resources then Dispensary of Hope. There you will have access to see formulary and enrollment information. You can also go to www.inspirahhealthnetwork.org

I have Medicare Part D, but my co-pays are too high can I enroll in Dispensary of Hope?

Unfortunately, no. Dispensary of Hope is only for those who currently do not have prescription coverage. If you have high co-pays, please look at www.needymeds.com they have resources that might be able to help lower your co-pays.

How long can I be enrolled with Dispensary of Hope?

Enrollment is updated every 6 months. Every 6 months a new Dispensary of Hope Checklist and Information Form must be filled out and given to the Inspira Mullica Hill or Inspira Vineland Retail Pharmacy. The pharmacy must keep the form on file.
